<u>1 Samuel 3:1</u> The boy Samuel ministered before the Lord under Eli. In those days the Word of the Lord was rare; there were not many visions. Cf. 1 Sam 3:19

Matthew 7:24&25 "Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock. The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock.

Mark 4:23&24 If anyone has ears to hear, let him hear." "Consider carefully what you hear," he continued. "With the measure you use, it will be measured to you--and even more.
